## Medications covered by Medicaid:

- **Nicotine Patches and Nicotine Gum:** Need a prescription order saying “over-the-counter”.
  - **Chantix® (Varenicline) and Zyban® (Bupropion):** Prescription needed.
  - **Nicotine Inhalers and Nicotine Nasal Sprays:** Prescription needed.

**How much medication coverage can I get?** You may be able to receive up to a 90 day supply of stop smoking medication twice a year.
